

## CMEA Hall of Fame Nomination Instructions

The CMEA Board of Directors established the Colorado Music Educators Hall of Fame at the 1984 Spring Board meeting:

*Recognizing the invaluable service and sacrifices given by members of the profession in bringing the best in music education to young people, we do hereby honor that service with the establishment of the Colorado Music Educators Hall of Fame*

To be eligible, the candidate must:

- be or have been an active member of CMEA;
- have served as an active music educator or administrator in music education in a Colorado public or private school, or institution of higher education, for a period of no less than twenty (20) years;
- have demonstrated excellence in teaching or administration in music;
- have brought about significant events or substantive improvement in the educational process, and/or
- have contributed significantly to the betterment of the profession through exemplary service or acts, and
- have demonstrated the highest ideals and professional integrity throughout the time of service.

*Induction to the Hall of Fame may also be done after retirement and posthumously.*

Nominees to the CMEA Hall of Fame may be made by individual members of CMEA, retired members of CMEA, members of other professional music education organizations, and/or teachers in other content areas. All nominations must be postmarked by October 20th of each year. The nominating sponsor should include at least eight letters of recommendation. All nominations must be postmarked by October 20 and include a photograph of the nominee.

A selection committee of six members, chaired by the CMEA Immediate Past President, shall include the chairs elect of the general music, vocal, instrumental, college/university councils and the retired membership chair. They will submit the names of the inductees, with a picture and biographical sketch to the CMEA president within seven days of the selection committee's decision meeting. Nominees not selected will be kept in active nomination status for a period of two (2) years.

Each inductee or inductee's family will receive a certificate at the President's Concert at the Annual Clinic/Conference. In addition, the Hall of Fame members are recognized in a display at the Imig Music Building at the University of Colorado at Boulder and at the CMEA Clinic/Conference. The Immediate Past President is in charge of preparing the displays.
