

## **Colorado Certificate Advancement Program Honors Designation Guidelines**

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Students performing in the Colorado Certificate Advancement Program may, at the discretion of the examiner (Judge), receive a designation of “Honors”. This designation will be printed on the certificate, if awarded. Honors may be awarded if all of the following criteria are fulfilled:

1. The student receives an overall score of 90 or higher
2. The student performs at least one piece at a higher level than the level for which they are playing. This level must be designated in the National ASTACAP Handbook and applies to pieces only, not to scales or etudes.
3. All scales and pieces in the student’s program are successfully memorized. Etudes need not be memorized to receive honors designation.

Please note: Honors Designation is awarded at the subjective discretion of the examiner (judge). It is not necessary for the student or teacher to apply for honors. If the above criteria are met, honors will be awarded.
